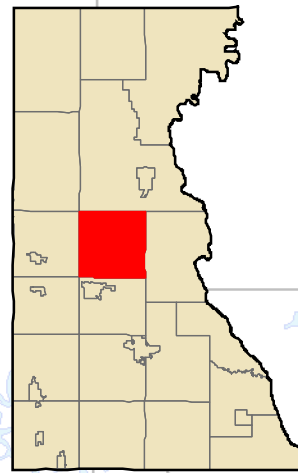

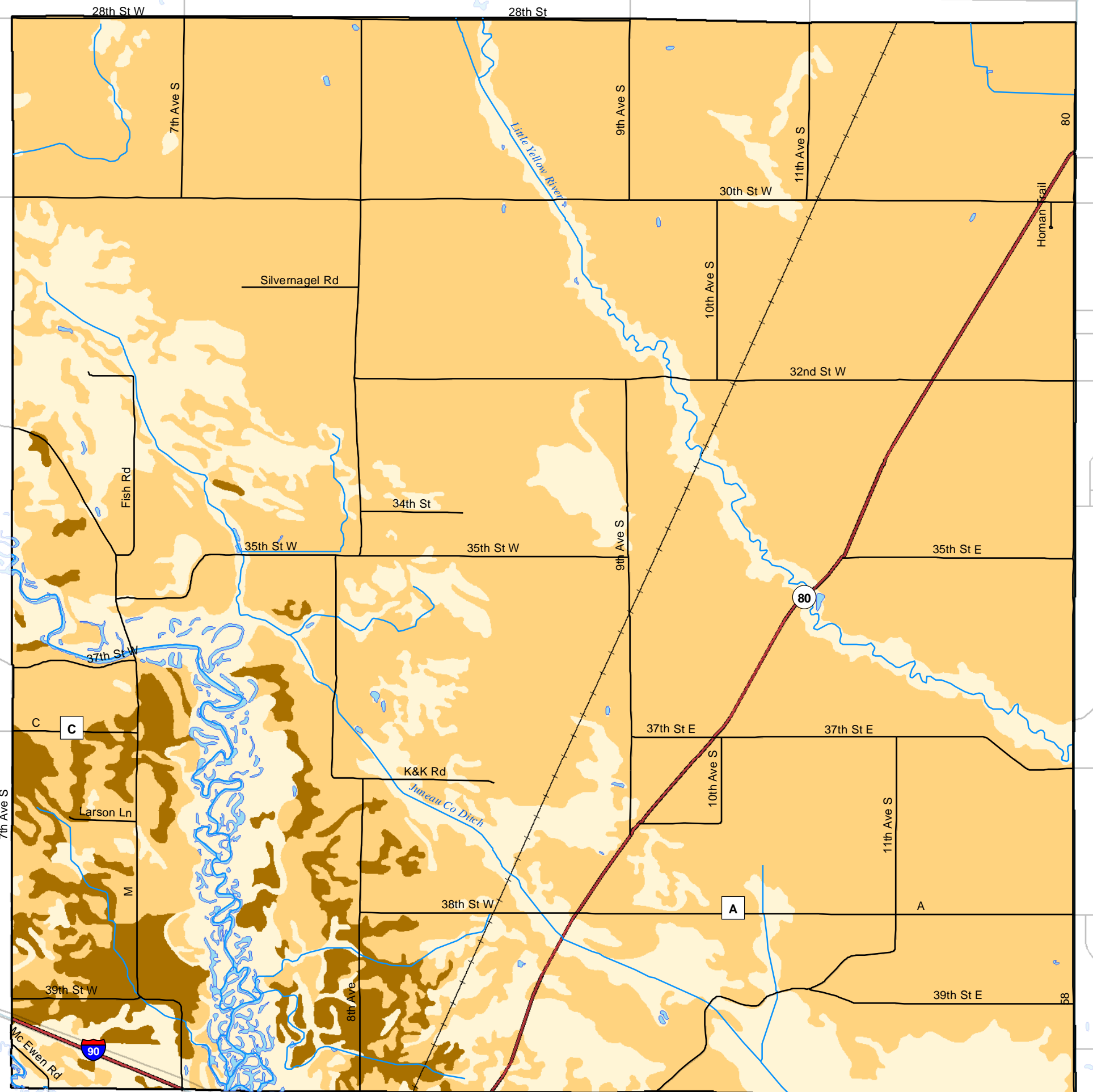

Areas labeled "Productive" indicate soil types which are capable of producing high yields of crops typically grown in the county under a high level of management. Productive soils are those which are capable of producing an average of 4 tons per acre per year of grass-legume hay, or 100 bushels per acre of corn. The Soil Conservation Service considers a "high level of management" to include provisions for adequate drainage, appropriate tillage, planting and seeding with high yielding varieties, control of weeds, diseases, insects, optimum fertilizer application and timely, efficient harvesting techniques.
